
Uni Hub Playford Terms of Use and Code of Conduct

Terms of use

By accessing Uni Hub Playford, users agree to comply with the Uni Hub Playford Code of Conduct. Failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct may result in restricted or revoked access.

- a. All users entering the hub must sign in before using the Uni Hub Playford
- b. Users of the Uni Hub Playford facility must be registered members, in accordance with the Uni Hub Playford Access and Registration Policy.
- c. All unregistered users, students or guests must sign in with Uni Hub Staff on arrival.
- d. Entry for unregistered students and guests is subject to staff approval on a case-by-case basis.
- e. Unregistered students and guests must comply with the Code of Conduct while using the facility.
- f. Unregistered students and guests are not permitted to use Uni Hub Playford computing or printing services unless expressly approved by staff.
- g. Entry outside of staffed hours is not permitted for unregistered users or guests.
- h. Uni Hub Playford is dedicated to supporting enrolled tertiary education student in their academic pursuits.
- i. Uni Hub Playford is not to be used as a temporary accommodation or shelter.
- j. Advice and services provided by Uni Hub Playford staff are general in nature and students should refer to their institution for guidance on specific academic requirements.

Code of conduct

Uni Hub Playford students, staff, contractors and visitors are expected to behave in a considerate and courteous manner when interacting with others.

Uni Hub Playford maintains a zero-tolerance approach to racism, discrimination, bullying and harassment. Violations may result in disciplinary action, including access restrictions.

Uni Hub Playford is dedicated to providing a safe learning environment for all members of the community. Uni Hub Playford's staff are obliged to take action if a student's behaviour is inappropriate or interferes with another members freedom.

Expectations of users

- a. Treat others with respect to ensure their health, safety, privacy and welfare are not compromised.
- b. Contribute to the orderly, effective and safe functioning of the Uni Hub Playford facility.
- c. Adhere to all Occupational Health, Safety and Welfare policies and procedures applicable to Uni Hub Playford.
- d. Comply with all lawful directions provided by Uni Hub Playford staff when on-site or participating in Uni Hub-sponsored activities.
- e. Users are responsible for their personal belongings and must keep them with them at all times.
- f. Seek guidance from staff if someone's behaviour is perceived to be in breach of the Code of Conduct.
- g. Uni Hub Playford users are responsible for their belongings and should be kept Be responsible for your belongings by always keeping them on you.
- h. Respect Uni Hub Playford equipment, supplies, and property, avoid waste, and limit excessive use of resources.
- i. Uni Hub Playford's technical and physical resources solely for legitimate study-related purposes.
- j. Users must not use Uni Hub Playford's internet or computer facilities for any inappropriate, unlawful, or unethical activities. This includes any use that may breach legal requirements, community standards, or the organisation's policies.
- k. Do not consume or be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs while at the Uni Hub Playford facility. Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited on-site.
